An oasis in the heart of downtown Baltimore

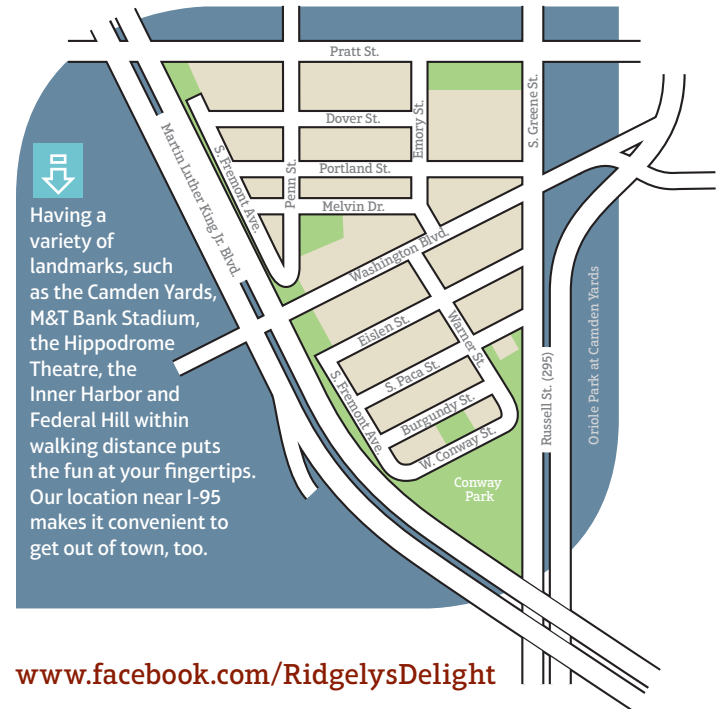
