Community Cleanup on May 7th

The Ridgely's Delight Association is continuing with volunteer monthly community cleanups. This month the cleanup will take place on Saturday, May 7th from 9am to 11am. Volunteers are needed to clean and remove debris and leaves from our streets. Residents interested in cleaning our streets please meet at the community tool shed at 9am.

Resident Parking Permit Renewal

Parking permits expire June 30, 2011. Residents can renew their permits online starting on or after Monday, May 23. Please note....that allows you to renew your permits and pay for them...but you can NOT pick up your permits at the Parking Authority until on or after June 20th, 2011.

The neighborhood pickup is scheduled for Thursday, June 23, 6-8 pm at 625 S. Paca St. (the same location its been for the past few years). In order to have your stickers for the Thursday pickup, you should pay for them online no later than 4pm, Wednesday, June 22. Any permits paid for after that may or may not be processed for the pickup. Please bring photo id and your vehicle registration (if applicable) to the neighborhood pickup.

Remember that all old parking stickers need to be REMOVED before installing your new stickers. That is a city ordinance...and you can receive a citation if you do not comply.

Please use your password from last year since. In the event you have forgotten it, you need to contact PACB at 443-573-2800 so we can reset the password for you. If you have had a permit last year, do not re-enter your information.
