# Community Happy Hour is April 1<sup>st</sup>



# ZipCars are in Ridgely's

What You May Not Know About ZipCars:

- Gas, insurance, and 180 free miles are included in your rental.
- Two cars (Honda Insight and Nissan Altima) are conveniently located at the corner of Portland and Greene St. Also, there are other walkable downtown locations if those cars are not available when you need them.
- If you are a ZipCar member, you can reserve cars in most metropolitan areas in the country. There are also ZipCars in England and Canada.
- Reserve your car in advance online
- There are many models to choose from including hybrids, convertibles, SUVs and pickup trucks.
- Parking spots are reserved for ZipCars so you pick up and drop off in the same spot. You no longer have to drive around looking for a parking space.
- Because you get a community discount, your annual fee is \$25 instead of \$60. And your hourly fee is \$7/hour instead of \$8-12/hour. There is a daily rate but it is not as cost efficient as a quick trip to the store.

### CHAP Regulations: How to OBTAIN APPROVAL for Exterior Changes to Your Property

Property owners may apply for exterior improvements by following these steps:

- PRIOR to making any changes, property owners MUST fill out a CHAP Notice to Proceed. Application: <u>http://www.baltimorecity.gov/Govern</u> <u>ment/BoardsandCommissions/HistoricalArchitectu</u> <u>ralPreservation/Applications.aspx</u>
- Exterior photos should accompany the application. Please contact the Ridgely's Delight Architectural Review Committee (ARC) at <u>RidgelysDelightARC@gmail.com</u>
- The committee meets on the first Wednesday of each month to review plans. Property owners are welcomed and encouraged to attend. Approved applications are forwarded to CHAP. Minor changes that comply with the guidelines can be approved between regular committee meetings.
- CHAP then issues a Notice to Proceed, enabling the property owner to obtain a building permit and undertake the improvements. Exterior painting does not require a building permit unless scaffolding is used, but CHAP and the Ridgely's Delight ARC must approve all paint colors.

If an owner does work without first obtaining a Notice to Proceed and a permit, he/she will be subject to housing code violations and fines.
