Have you been frustrated waiting at the eternal red light on Washington Blvd. at MLK or caught anyone speeding down Washington Blvd to make the waytoo-short green light at this intersection? Per our neighborhood's request, five more seconds of green light has been added to the traffic light for westbound Washington Blvd. In the spring, we are hoping to also get lane lines painted to filter cars into one lane for proceeding straight and turning left, and a second right-turn only lane. Until the lane lines are officially painted, please be aware of potential right turn on red traffic. Please approach the light and remain on the left side when turning left or going straight at MLK Blvd.


