Hazardous Waste Drop-off Returns

Baltimore City offers residents a safe way to dispose of household hazardous waste. These materials include oil-based paints, pesticides, herbicides, car and household batteries, drain cleaners, gasoline and pool chemicals. Note that latex paint is not hazardous waste; you can set out cans with dried paint for regular trash collection. You must show proof of city residency, e.g. a driver's license, telephone bill, or tax bill, to drop off waste. You must also be able to identify the material. Some materials will not be accepted as household hazardous waste, such as trash, asbestos, ammunition, fire extinguishers, industrial and medical wastes and radioactive materials, including smoke alarms with a radioactive symbol.


Businesses and private haulers must contract with a certified vendor to dispose of hazardous waste.
