Parking Permit Renewals are in June

Parking permits expire June 30, 2012. To pay for your renewal online, visit www.ci.baltimore.md.us/government/parking/rpp or pabc.t2hosted.com. A link to the site is also on the Ridgely's Delight homepage (www.ridgelysdelight.org). Residents who renew their pass(es) online by 5pm on the June 21st may take advantage of the neighborhood pick-up, which will take place at 625 S. Paca St. on Monday, June 25th from 5:30-7pm. To receive your pass(es) if you are unable to renew by the 21st or come to the neighborhood pick-up, you will need to go to the Parking Authority office at 200 W. Lombard St.
