New Bagged-Leaf Pick-Ups

The Bureau of Solid Waste will continue collecting bagged leaves on the regularly scheduled trash collection day. Solid Waste crews will collect up to five bags of leaves from each address every week. Residents need to put leaves in clear or labeled bags and not in the public right-of-way.

Also starting Monday, November 1, the Bureau will collect bagged leaves every Monday throughout the season with the exception of December 27 and January 17, 2011.
