Ridgely's Delight - a "trashy" hood?

The Ridgely's Delight Association would like to remind you to properly dispose of solid waste material. Violations of the Department of Public Works (DPW) regulations and City laws can result in citations and fines ranging from \$250 to \$500.

In an effort to enforce this policy, the Association will be issuing reminder notices and collecting all recycling/trash containers that are left in the public right of way, off personal property lines, during the October 9th cleanup. This enforcement effort is mainly due to the constant collection of trash cans at the corner of Bankard Ln. and Penn St. The collected containers will be available to reclaim at the dumpster located on Conway Street for a limited time on October 9th only (2-3 hours). Please make sure that your private trash container is stored on private property (back/side yard or inside your residence) or else you will loose it.

A New Ridgely's Improvement Committee

Five concerned residents of Dover St. have established a committee for the timely removal of the deteriorating buildings at the north end of Ridgely's Delight. The committee has learned that the possible demolition of the 723 Pratt St. Building, a University of Maryland Medical Systems (UMMS) property, has been postponed indefinitely. While we appreciate the efforts to preserve the historical integrity of Ridgely's Delight, there are several pertinent issues concerning this property that have been overlooked when evaluating the option of demolition. These concerns are primarily issues of safety, environmental impact, and fiscal responsibility. Plus, no person or authority has thus far been able to provide any evidence or explanation of the historical claim. If the 723 Pratt is not deemed a historical site, argument for saving it becomes moot.

As tax payers, home owners, and neighbors, we would like the other residents of our Ridgely's Delight community to be aware of the overall concerns of the 723 Pratt Street building.
